

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Michael Carrozzo, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Barbara Clara County is authorized to do the following:

- Extend the time periods provided in sections 583.310 and 583.320 of the Code of Civil Procedure to bring an action to trial by not more than 20 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(6).) This applies only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from March 16, 2020 to April 3, 2020, inclusive.
- Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code within which a trial must be held by not more than 20 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10).) This applies only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from March 16, 2020 to April 3, 2020, inclusive.
