

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 epidemic, leading to health and safety concerns resulting in a reduced jury pool and substantial operational impediments, and the proclamation of a state of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of San Diego County. On March 17, 2020, an Order issued at the request of Presiding Judge Lorna A. Alksne authorizing the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego (Court) to implement various forms of relief authorized by section 68115. This Order supplements that March 17, 2020 Order.

It is hereby ordered that the Superior Court of San Diego is also authorized to do the following:

- Declare that from March 17, 2020, to April 3, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4).)
