

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, causing numerous health and safety concerns, and the proclamations of states of emergency by Governor Newsom and President Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside. On March 17, 2020, an Order issued at the request of Presiding Judge John W. Vineyard authorizing the Court to implement relief authorized by section 68115. This Order supplements that March 17, 2020, Order. Upon the request of Presiding Judge John W. Vineyard, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Riverside County is authorized to do the following:

- Declare that from March 27, 2020, to April 3, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4));
- Declare that from March 27, 2020, to April 3, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 334 (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5)); and
- Declare that from March 19, 2020, to April 3, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing time under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 657 (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5)).
