

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of Sacramento County (Court). On March 17, 2020, an Order issued at the request of Presiding Judge Russell Hom authorizing the Court to implement various forms of relief authorized by section 68115. Upon, the further request of Presiding Judge Hom, it is ordered that the Court is additionally authorized to do the following:

- Extend by not more than 30 days the duration of any temporary restraining order that would otherwise expire from April 1, 2020, to April 30, 2020, inclusive, because the emergency condition described herein prevented the court from conducting proceedings to determine whether a permanent order should be entered. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(7).)

This order shall supplement the March 17, 2020, Order, which authorized additional relief pursuant to Government Code section 68115 in light of the above-described conditions.
