

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns, resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it was determined that the conditions described in Government Code section 68115(a) were met with regard to the Superior Court of San Diego County (Court) as of June 4, 2020. At the request of Presiding Judge Lorna A. Alksne, an order issued on that date authorizing the Court to implement certain relief authorized by section 68115(a). Upon further request of Presiding Judge Alksne seeking to supplement that June 4, 2020, order, and good cause appearing therefore, it is ordered that the Court is authorized to do the following:

- Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire on June 15, 2020 (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10); Executive Order N-38-20 (03-27-20)).
