## THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, causing health and safety concerns and findings by the California Department of Public Health that gatherings in venues that do not allow for social distancing of six feet per person should be cancelled, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Glenn. Due to the pandemic, Governor Gavin Newsom has declared a statewide state of emergency, and President Donald J. Trump has declared a national state of emergency. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Donald C. Byrd, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Glenn County is authorized to do the following:

 Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from March 23, 3030, to April 22, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
