

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of Nevada County (the Court). On March 16, 2020, and March 19, 2020, Orders issued at the request of Presiding Judge Linda J. Sloven, authorizing the Court to implement certain relief authorized by section 68115. Upon the further request of Presiding Judge Sloven, it is ordered that the Court is additionally authorized to do the following:

- Declare that any dates from March 16, 2020, to April 14, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4).
