

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a states of emergency by Governor Gavin Newsom and President Donald Trump, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of Riverside County (the Court). On March 17, 2020, and March 20, 2020, Orders issued at the request of Presiding John W. Vineyard, authorizing the Court to implement certain relief authorized by section 68115. Upon, the further request of Presiding Judge Vineyard, it is ordered that the Court is additionally authorized to do the following:

- Declare that any dates from March 23, 2020, to April 3, 2020, inclusive, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time under Penal Code section 825 (time to bring criminal defendant before magistrate after arrest). (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(5).)
