

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to health and safety concerns and resulting in substantial operational impediments, and the proclamations of states of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Mono. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Mark G. Magit, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Mono County is authorized to do the following:

- Extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days in cases in which the original statutory deadline otherwise would expire from August 24, 2020 through September 14, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
